Pursuant to NAPO's Bylaws, dues and assessments are as follows:

Section 1: There shall be minimum annual membership dues of \$200.00.

Section 2: The annual membership dues for each member organization shall be based on the number of individual members belonging to such organization, applying the following formula:

- a) 1 to 3,000 members - \$4.50 per member per year.
- b) 3,001 to 10,000 members – Subsection 2(a) plus \$3.50 for each member over 3,000.
- c) 10,001 to 15,000 members – Subsection 2(a) plus Subsection 2(b) plus \$3.00 for each member over 10,000.
- d) 15,001 or more members – Subsection 2(a) plus Subsection 2(b) plus Subsection 2(c) plus \$2.25 for each member over 15,000.
- e) The annual membership dues for members of all organizations of retired police officers shall be \$3.25 per member. Retired officers' organizations must be comprised of at least 51% retiree members.

There is a \$200 application fee as well as an assessment to fund our various seminars and annual meetings as follows:

For groups up to 100 members \$35 per event for a total of \$140 per year.

For groups over 100 members \$75 per event for a total of \$300 per year.
